ANNUAL REPORT FOR THE YEAR 2018-19

Rural Reconstruction and Rehabilitation Educational society (RRR EDUCATIONAL SOCIETY (RRRES)) is a secular, grass root level, voluntary organization working for the development of rural & urban poor in Andhra Pradesh State of India. It was registered under the Societies Registration Act XXI of 1860 in the year 1990. This is a non-profit organization with a sacred commitment for services to the unprivileged strata of Daliths, Fisher folk, Aged, Women, Children & Disabled Communities of Andhra Pradesh State. RRR Educational Society is an organization which is meant for the people. We consider ourselves as the voice and face of people who are deprived of the basic amenities like food, clothing, medicinal facilities, shelter and others. We work hard to help the needy children. As an organization we are highly inclined towards our social services to raise the bar of our societal/ mortal values. The Organization aims to develop the people by increasing their Social awareness and inculcating, self-sufficiency and solidarity among themselves. To reach the above targets, RRRES took up the following activities in this year i.e., 2018-19.

MOBILE VETERINARY CLINICS PROGRAMME:

With the financial assistance from Department of Animal Husbandry, Government of Andhra Pradesh, RRRES conducted two Mobile Veterinary Clinics (MVC) in Udayagiri and Venkatagiri Assembly Constituencies of SPSR Nellore District. For this programme, we appointed one Veterinary Doctor and one Para Vet to each Clinic. Two Vehicles taken on lease basis to run this programme in two Constituencies. Every day each MVC covered three villages, which were selected by Department of Animal Husbandry and given free treatment to all types of animals and also supplied medicines to the owners of animals.

NCLP SCHOOLS:

We are running two Special Training Centres for school dropout children and child labour in the age group of 8 to 14 years with the support of National Child Labour Project (NCLP). We opened these Centres at Devaradibba of Muthukur Mandal and Tadakaluru of Dagadarthi Mandal. We given education to the children with trained teachers and joined them in the regular schools after improving their skills in these centres.

ORGANISATION OF YANADI TRIBALS PROGRAMME:

RRRES has conducting awareness programmes in 20 villages of Dagadarthi and 40 villages of Buchi mandals, exclusively for the Yanadi tribals with the help of DKA-Austria, since Dec, 2008. Under this programme, RRRES has formed the yanadi tribal people as village level committees, SHGs, NREGS committees, community level committees. RRRES conducted Capacity Building Training to Village Samakya Leaders, Mandal Samakya Leaders, District Level Media Sensitization, and Training to Women Cooperatives. Identification of local problems, find solutions and take responsibility to resolve them are the main points discussed in the trainings. RRRES Activists lobby with Mandal and District Officials to sanction different Government Schemes to the beneficiaries in this year.

TRIBAL DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME:

With the kind financial assistance of LACIM, France, RRRES implemented various tribal development programmes towards empowerment of tribal communities, particularly Yanadi Tribals such as distribution of 20 goat units, Awareness on Animal Husbandry, Health camps for animal units and Training in Livestock Management in Pepalavari Palem village of Kavali Mandal, SPSR Nellore District. This programme helps to improve the economic status of 20 families and they have equipped with knowledge and skills of livestock management.

AGED CARE ACTIVITIES:

With the help of Holy Cross Ministries, Nellore we supported destitute aged by distribution of Blankets, Fruits and Food to the tune of Rs.21,520/- at Kavali. RRRES also conducted two health camps particularly for the destitute aged at Kavali town and distribute necessary medicines through doctors.

COMMUNITY BASED DISASTER PREPAREDNESS:

With the support of CADME/ UNICEF, RRRES implemented community Based Disaster preparedness programmes in Muthukur & Vidavalur Mandals of Nellore district. Under this programme, we were conducted training programmes to the Managing Committees of Multi Purpose Cyclone Shelters (MPCS) in 15 fishermen villages. In this programme, the experienced resource persons explained about how to make the MPCS as self sustainable.

ENVIRONMENTAL AWARENESS & PLANTATIONS

Under this programme, RRRES has mobilized plants from its donors and distributed the same in the villages. Before going for plantations, we conducted group meetings with the farmers and motivate

them to increase the greenery in and around their villages by plantations. We distributed 800 plants in eight villages of Dagadarthi Mandal during the month of December 2018.

AWARENESS ON PREVENTION OF ALCOHOLISM & DRUG ABUSE:

RRRES has conducted awareness campaigns in 6 villages of Muthukur and Dagadarthi Mandals on Alcoholism and its bad effects. Posters, pamphlets distribution, wall writings etc were done in the villages. Cultural programs conducted on alcohol using and its effects on health and atrocities on women. Televisions shows were also exhibited on health problem by smoking and alcoholism. The people participated have decided to avoid taking liquors and women decided to ban on selling wine in the villages.

HEALTH CAMPS:

RRRES has conducted 2 Health Camps in Devaradibba and Pynapuram villages of Muthukur Mandal. We focused on health problems on Scheduled Tribe families. The Doctors, who came to the health camps, distributed medicines to the identified patients.

AWARENESS ON ANIMAL HUSBANDRY:

RRRES conducted Awareness Programme on Animal Husbandry in improvement of milk production among farmers in 2 mandals in this year. How to prepare nutritious feed with locally available millets, precautions to avoid diseases to the milk animals and other suggestions to the farmers through this Campaign.

TRAINING IN LIVESTOCK MANAGEMENT:

We were conducted training in Live Stock Management i.e., using best serum to produce healthy animals, Identification of diseases occurred to the buffaloes, goats and sheep and immunization methods and treatment to the diseases are the main topics deal in this Campaign. This Awareness Campaign conducted at 10 villages of 2 mandals in SPSR Nellore District in this year.
