ANNUAL REPORT FOR THE YEAR 2019-20

Rural Reconstruction and Rehabilitation Educational society (RRR EDUCATIONAL SOCIETY (RRRES) is a secular, gross root level, voluntary organization working for the development of rural & urban poor in Andhra Pradesh State of India. It was registered under the Societies Registration Act XXI of 1860 in the year 1990. This is a non-profit organization with a sacred commitment for services to the un-privileged strata of Daliths, Fisher folk, Aged, Women, Children & Disabled Communities of Andhra Pradesh State. RRR Educational Society is an organization which is meant for the people. We consider ourselves as the voice and face of people who are deprived of the basic amenities like food, clothing, medicinal facilities, shelter and others. We work hard to help the needy children. As an organization we are highly inclined towards our social services to raise the bar of our societal/ mortal values. The Organization aims to develop the people by increasing their Social awareness and inculcating, self-sufficiency and solidarity among themselves. To reach the above targets, RRRES took up the following activities in this year i.e., 2019-20.

MOBILE VETERINARY CLINICS PROGRAMME:

With the financial assistance from Department of Animal Husbandry, Government of Andhra Pradesh, RRRES conducted two Mobile Veterinary Clinics (MVC) in Udayagiri and Venkatagiri Assembly Constituencies of SPSR Nellore District. For this programme, we appointed one Veterinary Doctor and one Para Vet to each Clinic. Two Vehicles taken on lease basis to run this programme in two Constituencies. Every day each MVC covered three villages, which were selected by Department of Animal Husbandry and given free treatment to all types of animals and also supplied medicines to the owners of animals.

NCLP SCHOOLS:

We are running two Special Training Centres for school dropout children and child labour in the age group of 8 to 14 years with the support of National Child Labour Project (NCLP). We running these Centres at Devaradibba of Muthukur Mandal and Tadakaluru of Dagadarthi Mandal. We given education to the children with trained teachers and joined them in the regular schools after improving their skills in these centres.

DISTRIBUTION OF LIVE STOCK UNITS:

With the kind financial assistance of LACIM, France, RRRES implemented various tribal development programmes towards empowerment of tribal communities, particularly Yanadi Tribals such as distribution of 10 goat units to 10 families and Training in Livestock Management to the beneficiaries in Pepalavari Palem village of Kavali Mandal, SPSR Nellore District. This programme helps to improve the economic status of 10 families and they have equipped with knowledge and skills of livestock management.

HEALTH CAMPS:

RRRES has conducted 2 Health Camps at Pepalavari Palem village of Kavali Mandal. We focused on health problems on Scheduled Tribe families. The Doctors, who came to the health camps, distributed medicines to the identified patients with the financial assistance of LACIM, France.

AWARENESS ON ANIMAL HUSBANDRY:

RRRES conducted Awareness Programme on Animal Husbandry in improvement of mild production among farmers at Pepalavari Palem village of Kavali Mandal in this year. How to prepare nutritious feed with locally available millets, precautions to avoid diseases to the milk animals and other suggestions to the farmers through this Campaign.

TRAINING IN LIVESTOCK MANAGEMENT:

We were conducted training in Live Stock Management i.e., using best serum to produce healthy animals, Identification of diseases occurred to the buffaloes, goats and sheep and immunization methods and treatment to the diseases are the main topics deal in this Campaign. This Awareness

Campaign conducted at Pepalavari Palem village of Kavali Mandal in SPSR Nellore District in this year with the assistance of LACIM, France.

AWARENESS ON COVID 19:

RRRES conducted Awareness Programme on COVID-19 prevention among rural population in the month of March, 2020. Wearing masks, use of sanitizers and maintain social distance are the main topics highlighted in this Campaign at 5 villages of Muthukur and Dagadarthi mandals of SPSR Nellore District.

AWARENESS ON SWATCH BHARATH PROGRAMME:

To maintain clean and green surroundings, which helps to improve good health conditions of public is the main topic covered under Swatch Bharath Programme. We created awareness on public to dispose the dry waste and wet waste separately and co-operate to the sanitary workers to dispose scientifically and also to maintain the clean surrounding in their surrounding areas of their houses as well as their streets.
