ANNUAL REPORT FOR THE YEAR 2020-21

Rural Reconstruction and Rehabilitation Educational society (RRR EDUCATIONAL SOCIETY (RRRES)) is a secular, grass root level, voluntary organization working for the development of rural & urban poor in Andhra Pradesh State of India. It was registered under the Societies Registration Act XXI of 1860 in the year 1990. This is a non-profit organization with a sacred commitment for services to the un-privileged strata of Daliths, Fisher folk, Aged, Women, Children & Disabled Communities of Andhra Pradesh State. RRR Educational Society is an organization which is meant for the people. We consider ourselves as the voice and face of people who are deprived of the basic amenities like food, clothing, medicinal facilities, shelter and others. We work hard to help the needy children. As an organization we are highly inclined towards our social services to raise the bar of our societal/ mortal values. The Organization aims to develop the people by increasing their Social awareness and inculcating, self-sufficiency and solidarity among themselves. To reach the above targets, RRRES took up the following activities in this year i.e., 2020-21.

NCLP SCHOOL:

We are running two Special Training Centre for school dropout children and child labour in the age group of 8 to 14 years with the support of National Child Labour Project (NCLP). We running these Centre at Devaradibba of Muthukur Mandal. We given education to the children with trained teachers and joined them in the regular schools after improving their skills in these centres.

DISTRIBUTION OF RATION KITS TO LOCKDOWN AFFECTED FAMILIES:

With the kind financial assistance of LACIM, France, RRRES implemented various tribal development programmes towards empowerment of tribal communities, particularly Yanadi Tribals since 10 years. This year we distributed Ration Kits to 35 yanadi tribal families at Pepalavari Palem village of Kavali Mandal, SPSR Nellore District, who are the victims of COVID-19 Lockdown. This programme helped to feed their families for 30 days.

AGED CARE ACTIVITIES:

We supported destitute aged by distribution of Blankets, Fruits and Food to the tune of Rs.32,585/- at Kavali. RRRES also conducted two health camps particularly for the destitute aged at Kavali town and distribute necessary medicines through doctors.

FARMERS PRODUCERS ORGANISATION:

We organised the farmers and formed them as Farmers Producers Organisations at Buchireddypalem and Kavali Mandals, SPSR Nellore District to avoid the middle men to sell their crops and also get benefits from Agricultural Department. This programme was supported by NABARD. We encouraged the farmers to horticulture crops in these mandals.

AWARENESS ON COVID 19:

RRRES conducted Awareness Programme on COVID-19 prevention among rural population in the month of June, 2021. Wearing masks, use of sanitizers and maintain social distance are the main topics highlighted in this Campaign at 5 villages of Muthukur and Dagadarthi mandals of SPSR Nellore District.

AWARENESS ON SWATCH BHARATH PROGRAMME:

To maintain clean and green surroundings, which helps to improve good health conditions of public is the main topic covered under Swatch Bharath Programme. We created awareness on public to dispose the dry waste and wet waste separately and co-operate to the sanitary workers to dispose scientifically and also to maintain the clean surrounding in their surrounding areas of their houses as well as their streets.

DISTRIBUTION OF MASKS AND SANITIZERS:

RRRES distributed Masks and Sanitizers to prevent COVID-19 infection to public among rural areas in the July, 2021. We distributed the Masks and Sanitizers in 2 villages of Kavali mandal of SPSR Nellore District.
